News From San Francisco

Robert Burns visited Douglas on the 13th, stayed with us two days and left for Hawaii.

Mr. Leon Levy was ordained by Rev. Lusardi on July 16th in a very beautiful service. After the service we had the pleasure of giving a reception at our house for their guests.

On July 19th George and I visited Pauline in Benkeley and played the tape for a student minister. He scoffed at the word "Revelation".

On July 29th we held a party. Dr. Richard Leeds of the Presbyterian Medical Center spoke on modern medicine. Seventeen people attended and enjoyed the party. We explained the spirit world to Dr. Leeds, who is a member of the Uniterian Church. He was much convinced and wanted to know more about it.

I had the pleasure of speaking at Rev. Lusardi's Church on Tyly 30th. He had put an advertisement in the paper, so 30 people were present. Rev. Levy said that it was their largest crowd for a regular service.

Our friend Bill Moris has visited us week ends and has attended Friday meetings. He is much better and eager to spread our message. However his course doesn't seem to be so easy. I want all of you to pray for him.

There have been Nevil's Meetings and the Seventh Day Adventists World Convention held in San Francisco. We visited both and gave our cards and handbills.

Nevil, the founder, spoke at the Nevil's meeting. He says that Jesus is not a historical figure and also emphasizes the power of man's imagination through which one can produce extra sensory phenomena.

At the Seventh Day Adventists Convention I heard during each meeting both the speakers and delegates say "the coming of the Lord is very near, so let us quickly finish our work". A man from Florida and a woman from Canada came to our house and heard the message. Both of them said that the convention offers nothing and what they teach is false teaching. The convention was held at the Civic Audetoriam where 12000 delegates were present.

On Aug. 5th I visited Doris in San Jose. Mr. Lofland kindly drove me down. Miss Felse and her mother and Doris kindly received us and gave us dinner. I spoke to Miss Felse who was disturbed by the part of the message that says Jesus did not fulfill his mission. In the evening five ladies gathered together. By using the tape I explained our message. Many questions were raised of course. We talked until 11:30. I believe they will study the Divine Principles more with the book. After midnight we came back.

On Aug. 8th I visited a Lesbians' Club in city. There were 20 girls present who were not interested in religion. He revealed several things that even the newspapers could not report. After his talk I explained our movement, placed the preface and invited the guests to hear our message. On Aug. 12th, we had the pleasure of having Miss Enid Lee with us. She lives in Castro Valley but met Pauline in Berkeley. Through Miss Lee we sent books to new age groups in New York and Ghana, West Africa.
